How to determine your ring size

Choose between three measuring methods

Prior to printing, ensure that page scaling is at 100%

(1) Measure your finger with our paper sizer.

- Print and gently cut along the outline of our paper sizer.
- Cut a slit where indicated and insert the pointed end of the sizer.
- Wrap the sizer around the finger with the numbers facing out.
- Slide the pointed end of the sizer through the slit.
- Move the sizer to the largest part of the finger on the knuckle.
- Pull tightly. The sizer must fit snugly to produce an accurate size.
- The number that lines up at the slit represents the ring size for that finger.
- For the most accuracy, have someone help you to measure and double check.

NOTE: Measure your finger when it is at his largest, at the end of the day.

Check size of current ring.

- · Select a ring that properly fits the intended finger.
- Place the ring over the circles on the right, matching the inside edge of the ring to the circle nearest in size until you find the perfect match.


You have selected the perfect circle. Its number should fit your finger

3 Measure the inside diameter of current ring.

- Select a ring that properly fits the intended finger.
 Measure with a ruler the inside diameter of the rin
 - Measure with a ruler the inside diameter of the ring.Compare with the circles on your right to find the perfect match.
 - Compare with the circles on your right to find the perfect match

If the ring falls between two sizes, order the larger size.
